

Join our exciting quest to find the Lechuguilla Agave, a super sneaky desert plant. It likes to hide underground, but you can spot its twisty leaves above the sand.





### **Different Types of Pollinators**

#### Insects

#### Wind

- Happy Environment: When we see lots of pollinators, it means our environment is happy and healthy.


